Proposition: The bible teaches gospel mission so let's invite it to school our missiology

Notes: The purpose of this lesson is to answer the following two questions:

1. What does the Bible teach about mission?
 - a. Wherever we go we should make disciples. Matt. 28:16-20; Acts 1:6-11; Eph. 2:19-22
 - b. Some must go, others must stay. Matt. 9:35-38
 - c. The church is the global mission. John 13:34-35; 1 Thess. 4:9-1; Acts 2:42-47.
2. How does this biblical perspective affect our missiology?
 - a. Full faith for whatever God has called us to in the moment. Matt. 13:31-33
 - b. We are looking for a substantive partnership and to be open, affirming, and evaluating of all mission opportunities.

Questions:
