The class assistant should ask children to come to them to recite their verse at the beginning of class. The child can be given one prompt and still earn a Bible Buck. If they require more than one prompt their verse is not considered memorized. They can retry a few times before they are told to study the verse again. There is a spot on the roster for you to mark a total tally of recited verses. At the end of class, if the teacher has finished the lesson, instead of resorting to playing a game (like thumbs-up 7-up) the teacher is strongly encouraged to help the class learn next week's verse. Easy methods to teach new verse could be: Erase-a-Word (write verse and reference on board and erase one word between reading it) or Make-a-Motion (have class come up with motions for words in the verse). Picture representation: Write the verse and have the class help you to know what pictures to draw to represent words. Feel free to use your own creativity as well.
